NEW YORK, April 16, 2015—Touchstone will publish a collection of humorous, autobiographical essays by celebrated actress Anna Kendrick. The yet-to-be-titled book will be published in fall 2016. An audio edition will be released simultaneously by Simon & Schuster Audio.

One of America's most popular and versatile actresses of stage and screen, nominated for an Academy Award for her breakout role in "Up in the Air," Anna Kendrick's autobiographical book will amusingly recount memorable moments throughout her life, from her middle class upbringing in New England to the blockbuster movies that have made her one of Hollywood's most popular actresses today. Expanding upon the witty and ironic dispatches for which she is known, Anna Kendrick's essays will offer her one-of-a-kind commentary on the absurdities she's experienced on her way to and from the heart of pop culture.

"I'm excited to publish my first book, and because I get uncomfortable when people have high expectations, I'd like to use this opportunity to showcase my ineptitude, pettiness, and the frequency with which I embarrass myself," said Anna Kendrick. "And while many of my female inspirations who have become authors are incredibly well-educated and accomplished comedy writers, I'm very, very funny on Twitter, according to *Buzzfeed* and my mom, so I feel like this is a great idea. Quick question: are run-on sentences still frowned upon? Wait, is ending a sentence with a preposition still frowned upon? I mean, upon frowned? Dammit!"

Perfect" film franchises. In 2013, she achieved musical success with the #2 Billboard hit song

"Cups (When I'm Gone)," featured in "Pitch Perfect." She will star in "Pitch Perfect 2," in

theaters on May 15.
