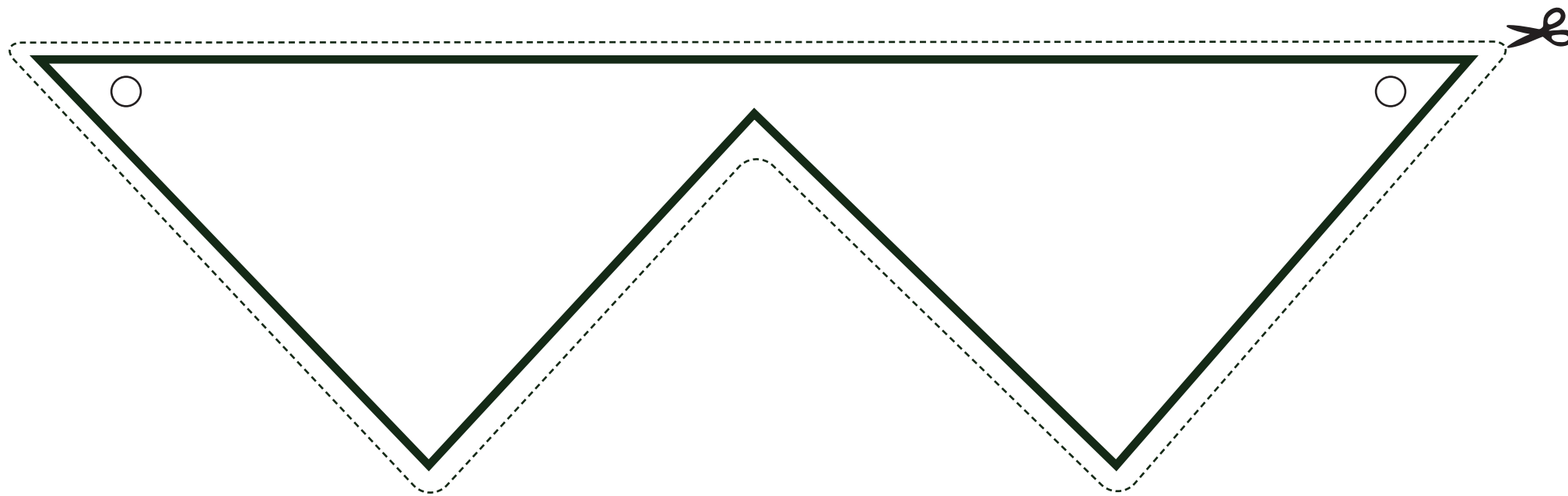

DESIGN YOUR OWN FUTURISTIC GLASSES!

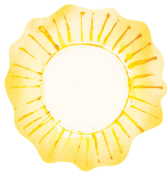
- 1** Decorate the glasses however you like!
Use coloured pencils, crayons, paint, stickers or whatever you prefer.
- 2** Once the design is finished, ask an adult to help you cut out the glasses. Remember to follow the dotted line!
- 3** Poke through the 2 holes on each end of the glasses – you can use pens, pencils or pop-sticks. These are so you can hold your glasses.

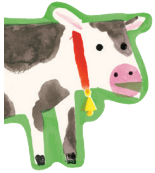

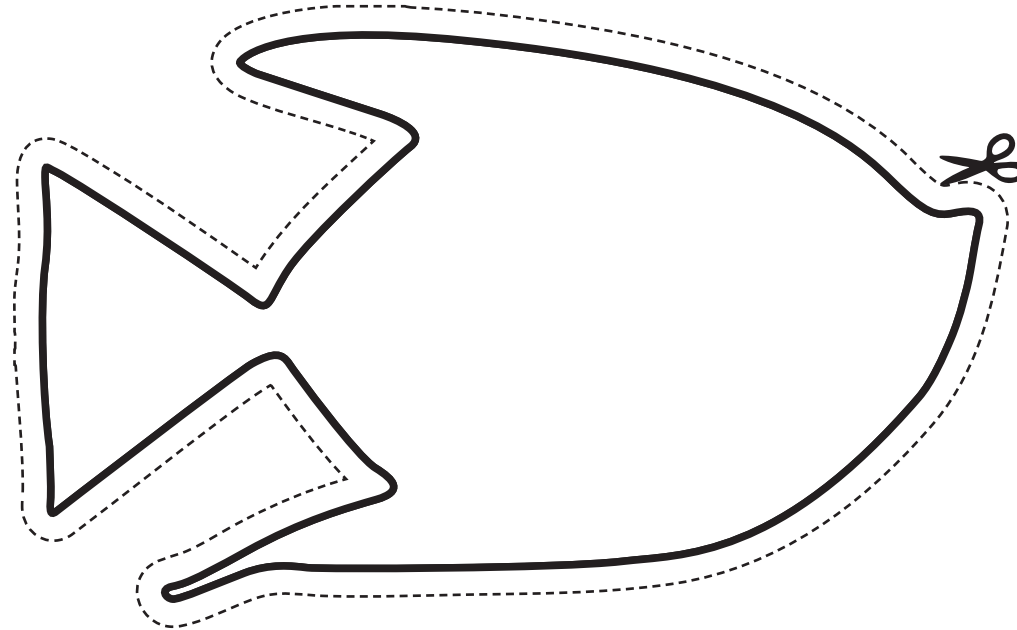

DESIGN YOUR OWN FISH HEADBAND!

- 1 Decorate the fish and headband however you like! Use coloured pencils, crayons, paint, stickers or whatever you prefer.
- 2 Once the design is finished, ask an adult to help you cut out the fish headband. Remember to follow the dotted line!
- 3 Use glue or sticky tape to join the two patterned ends of the headband together to form a loop around your head.
- 4 Now you have your very own custom fish headband. Give it to someone you want to say 'thank you' to, and make sure they put it on their head. That's how you say thank you in the future after all!
