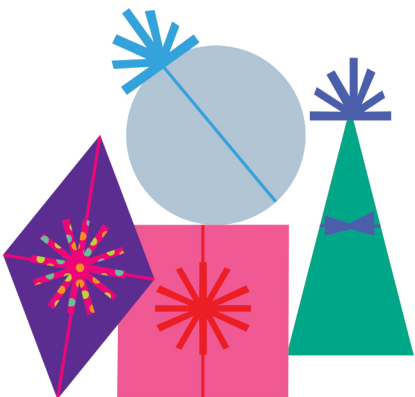
Your Name Is a Gift!

given as a gift that starts with your special letter?

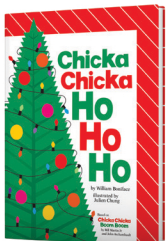
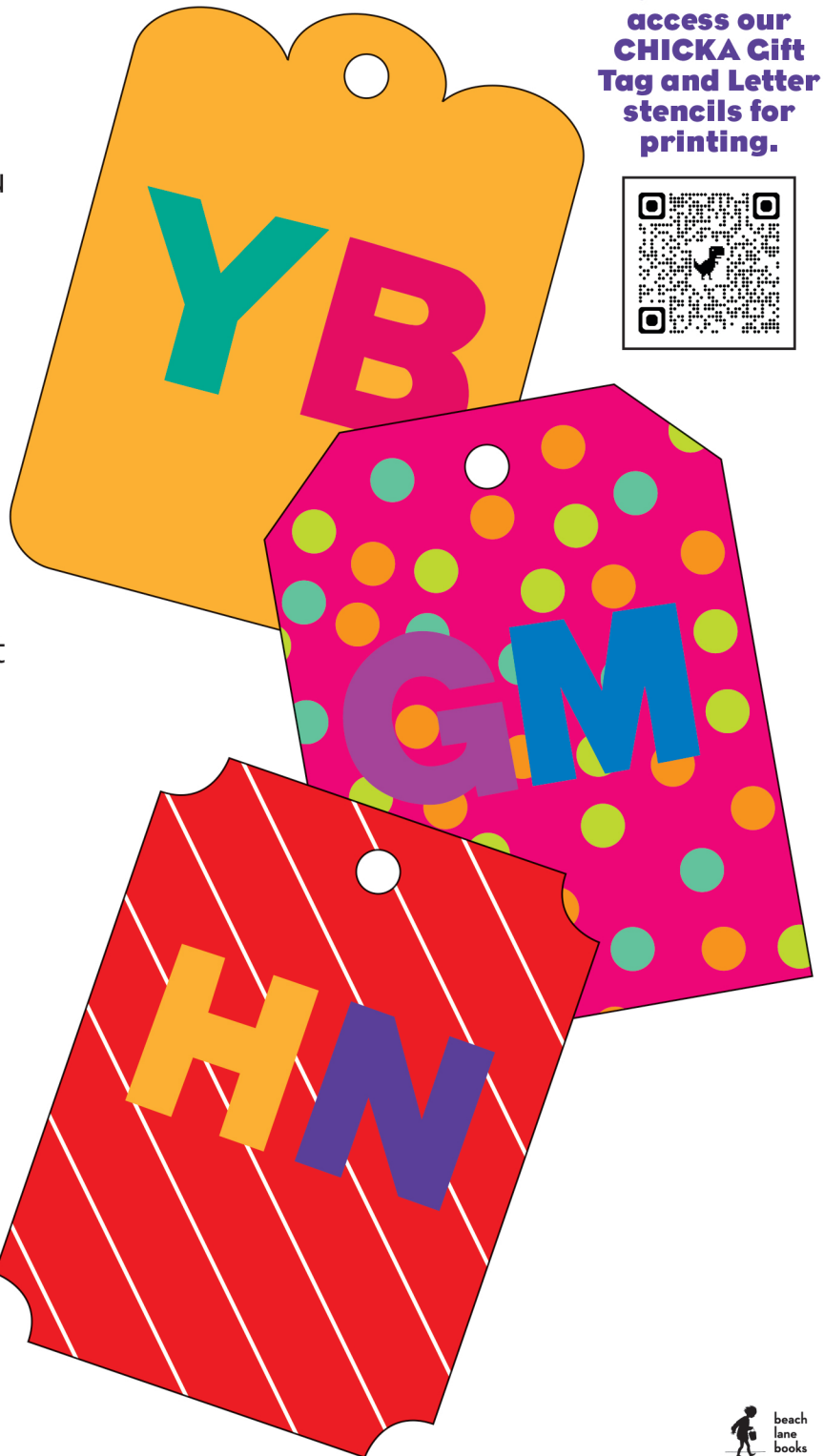

The Season of Giving!

One of the best ways to spread joy and love is by giving a thoughtful gift. Follow the instructions below to make your own Chicka Chicka gift tag!

1. Scan the QR code and print out the gift tag and letter stencils, as many as you need. Have an adult help you cut out the stencils and any letters you may want to use.
2. Grab some paper. It can be colorful, striped, polka dotted, wavy, or any other fun design you can find!
3. Trace the tag and letter stencils over your desired papers. Make sure you are using at least two different kinds.
4. Have an adult help to cut out the tags and letters you just drew on the paper.
5. Use a glue stick or tape to put them together.
6. You have your tag! Attach it to your gift and see what other colorful combinations you can create!

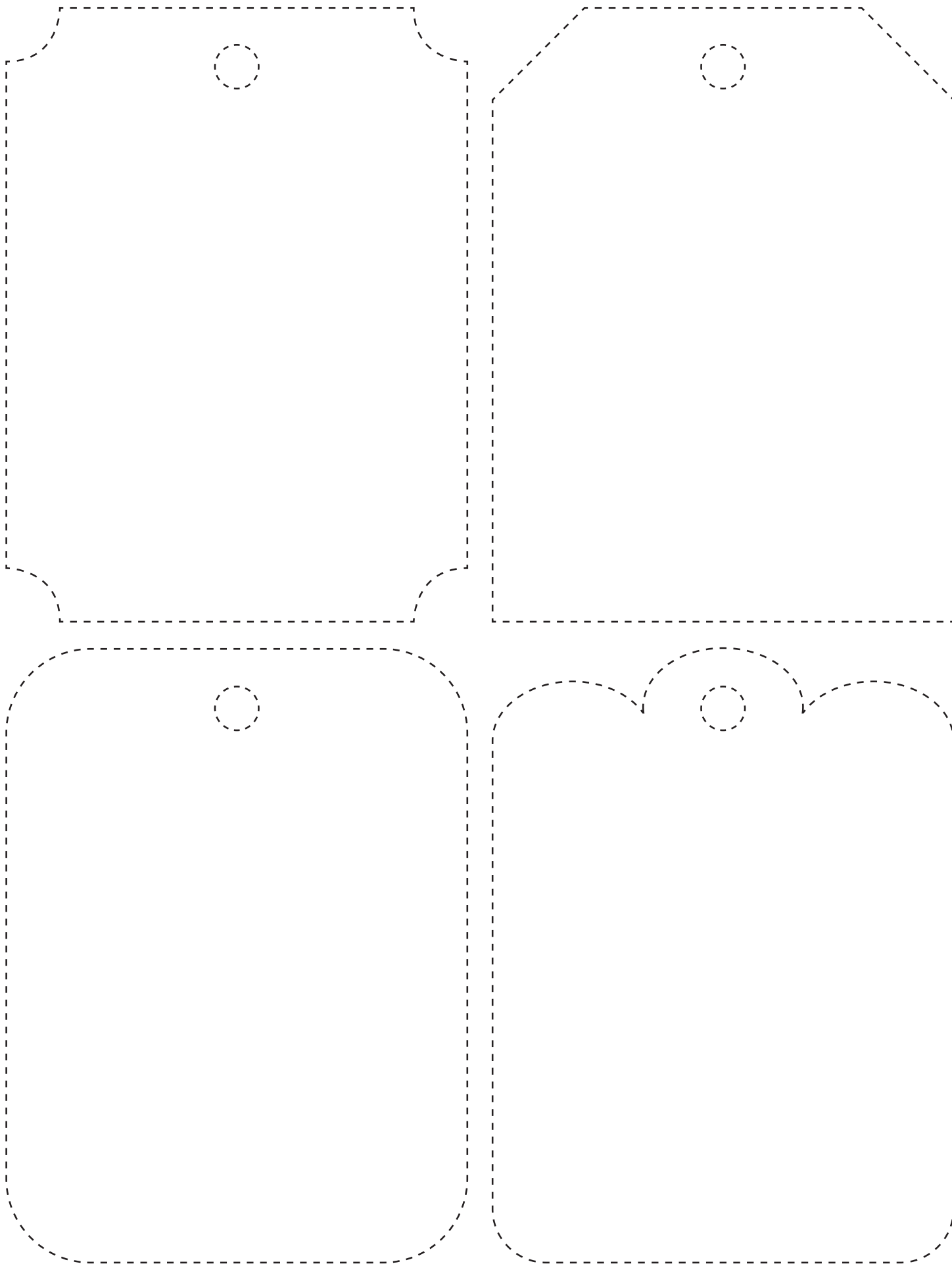
